APPLICATIONS

Jubilee Memorial Scholarship applications are invited in January each year from students, who are permanent residents in New Zealand undertaking technical or university education at New Zealand tertiary institutions.

APPLICATION FORMS

Forms are available on request from Grand Superintendents of Districts as listed on our web site www.royalarch.org.nz. All applications, together with examination results must be provided to Grand Superintendents by 31 January. Grand Superintendents must forward four (4) copies together with their recommendations to reach the Grand Scribe Ezra by 15th February.

Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.

REQUIREMENTS

- a) Applicants must supply **FIVE** copies of
 - i) this Application Form, AND
 - ii) either tertiary examination results for the past year, OR
 - iii) their final NZQA Qualification & Achievement Summary.

The sets of documents are to be stapled together for the Scholarship Council, one is retained by the District Grand Superintendent and one set by Grand Scribe Ezra. All photocopies must be legible.

If full results are not available by 31st January, send the application to the Grand Superintendent advising when results will be available. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification of the application.

- b) Scholarship awards are not automatically renewed. Students who wish to apply in subsequent years must complete a new application form each year supported by certified copies of the previous year's results.
- c) All copies of examination results must be certified as such by a Justice of the Peace or person of equivalent standing in the community.
- d) Scholarships are awarded based on the information supplied. The decisions of the Scholarship Council are final.
