Freemasons Speed-dating

Many of us, especially new members of the Lodge do not know one another very well. Or we attend a District meeting and don't know the other Brethren present.

Freemasons speed-dating is a unique, fun and interesting way to inform us more about the background of other Brethren. Also it is a good technique to share views on a particular topic. It can be done in Lodge, in refectory or at a meeting. This is how it works.

- 1. Explain that each brother has 40 to 50 sec to talk about 3 things:
 - a. Their name and their Lodge (if different Lodges are represented)
 - b. Their occupation or if retired their occupation when they retired
 - c. A topic at the regional workshop in 2015 we selected: 'What are your expectations of being a Freemason'
- 2. Explain the first brother has to talk for the full period until instructed to swap over
- 3. Take half the Brethren present and get them to stand in a circle a little spread out facing outwards. Ask the remaining Brethren to partner off, facing them.
- 4. Start the introductions with the inner circle and then after 60sec tell them to swap.
- 5. After a further 60 sec yell 'Stop' and ask the outer row to rotate clockwise to their left. Start the process all over again.
- 6. As the speed-dating progresses you can quicken the pace a little.
- 7. Continue the exercise until the first pairings are matched again or until your time allocation has been reached not necessary to get all the way around.
- 8. Debrief the topic what were the key reflections from others shared?

Give this a try – the results could well be very interesting.
