Freemasons are encouraged to make a daily advancement in Masonic knowledge. We're also encouraged to provide a variety of educational opportunities during our regular meetings.

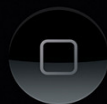
So here's a quiz as attached with a difference- it requires the brethren to move around.
