



Exploring the Tools Evening

The Tools in the Toolbox on the Grand Lodge website are written as helpful suggestions for enhancing Lodge activities and management. Very few brethren have taken the time out to discover the tools. This is a great opportunity to do so involving the brethren in a Lodge participatory education evening.

- FORMAT:** Discussion groups and report back – total time between 50 to 70mins.
- PRESENTER/S:** Requires a competent brother to facilitate the session; and a recorder to capture the input of the brethren.
- AUDIENCE:** All Lodge members
- VENUE:** Lodge Room

APPROACH:

The facilitator should download a selection of Tools from the website. On the meeting night divide the brethren present into discussion groups of 5 to 6 brethren.

Ask each discussion group to appoint a brother to feedback. Then give each discussion group 2 to 4 Tools and ask them to consider for 15 to 20mins the selection of Tools, choose the Tool they prefer and then discuss how it might be applied to your Lodge.

Ask each brother nominated to give feedback to give a short 3 to 5min report back to the meeting.

Finish with opening up the discussion to the meeting to get the thought of the brethren on the preferred options and how they could be applied.
