Introducing Brethren of the Lodge Evening

How often do we attend a funeral of a brother and learn about the many exploits in his life? Many of the brethren in our Lodges have very interesting backgrounds and interests which we do not know about.

This session is an opportunity for your brethren to get to know the members of the Lodge better.

FORMAT: 45 to 60min session involving presentations by a number

of brethren. It may be appropriate to use AV for

projection of images during this session.

PRESENTER/S: Requires a competent brother to facilitate the session.

AUDIENCE: All Lodge members and possibly others

VENUE: Lodge Room / refectory

APPROACH:

The facilitator should identify a number of brethren (say 8 -10) (possibly randomly out of the hat at the meeting before) and pair them off at least 1 month before the proposed evening.

Each pair is asked to get together before the next meeting, interview each other and then prepare a 3 to 6 min introduction of each other. Remember 3mins is about 200 – 250 words.

Brethren may wish to compliment this with a visual presentation with between 9 to 15 images (20sec's per image).

On the meeting night the facilitator should give a brief introduction and then ask each brother to speak in turn.

Finish by allowing the brethren to ask questions or share some observations.
