- Ensure development and awareness of all members
- Facilitate the involvement of all brethren with a consistent approach and balanced delegation
- Have empathy, tolerance, harmony demonstrated
- Ensure confidence of / in Worshipful Master
- Identify up and coming Leaders
- Recognise the different Leadership styles of the brethren
- Encourage good communication with active listening
- Ensure variation of activities - have social activity involvement
- Have self confidence
- Encourage team-work to share the load
- All use the same "song sheet"
- Demonstrate sound chairmanship skills
- Foster mentoring of *all* leaders in the Lodge
- Adjust communication styles to suit the occasion and need
