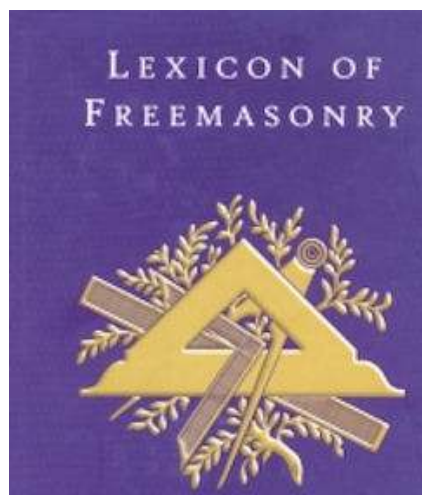




Share the Lexicon of Freemasonry

Freemason's ceremonies use many terms / words which are unfamiliar to most brethren. Ensure the members of your Lodge have the opportunity to understand such terms by sharing this Lexicon. In doing so assist them to better understand the learning's in the three degree ceremonies.

A lexicon is the vocabulary of a person, language, or branch of knowledge (such as military or masonic). In linguistics, a lexicon is a language's inventory of lexemes. The word "lexicon" derives from the Greek word 'lexicos' meaning "of or for words".



The attached Lexicon of Freemasonry, therefore, contains most of the unique words and sayings practised in the three degrees and provides a modern day translation or definition.
