



## SUPREME GRAND ROYAL ARCH CHAPTER OF NEW ZEALAND

### JUBILEE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

#### **Background**

The Supreme Grand Royal Arch Chapter of New Zealand provides for Jubilee Memorial Scholarships to be awarded annually.

The scholarships, tenable for one year and renewal on further application, are available for technical training, vocational training, tertiary or professional education at any tertiary or other educational institution in New Zealand approved by the Scholarship Council.

Scholarships are awarded without regard to gender, ethnic background, creed or age.

#### **Criteria**

Applicants for scholarships must:

- a) Have a good academic record having completed secondary school or college and be progressing to further tertiary education or training; and
- b) Be a New Zealand citizen or hold permanent NZ residency; and
- c) Demonstrate good citizenship and be involved in some form of community activity supported by a referee's report.

#### **Awards**

Awards are made by the Jubilee Memorial Scholarship Council on the basis of information supplied. Late, incomplete or applications lacking information will not be considered.

The Council's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

#### **Additional Prizes**

Successful applicants may also qualify for consideration for one of the four Memorial Prizes awarded at the same time. These are the G.C. Palliser, J.W. Jowers, E.W. Atkinson and the Fletcher/Wilson Memorial Awards.

#### **Privacy**

The information requested on the Application Form will be used solely for the purpose of assessing your application. The Supreme Grand Royal Arch Chapter of New Zealand may use the personal information of successful awardees for promotional purposes.

#### **Applications**

Completed applications (5 copies), signed and dated, must be lodged by the applicant with the appropriate District Grand Superintendent of The Grand Chapter of New Zealand, by August 31 in each year.
