



Visiting as a Freemason in Australia

Australia is the most visited destination by New Zealanders so more NZ Freemasons will be visiting across the 'ditch' than anywhere else. With the strong fraternal bonds between the Australian Grand Lodges and the Grand Lodge of NZ, as well as similarity in ceremony, it is one of the easiest places for a NZ freemason to undertake a Masonic visit overseas.

There are six Australian Grand Lodges:

United Grand Lodge of NSW and Australian Capital Territory

United Grand Lodge of Queensland

Grand Lodge of South Australia and Northern Territory

Grand Lodge of Tasmania

United Grand Lodge of Victoria

Grand Lodge of Western Australia
