Many Districts or combined Districts produce monthly lists announcing the particular meeting activities in their patch. For more information about lodge meetings in a District, either contact Lodges directly, or contact the District Grand Master.

Remember that when you visit if there is no one from the Lodge you are visiting who can vouch for you as a freemason then you may need to produce your Master Mason Certificate and you may need to be proved. This means that you should be prepared to give the handshakes and passwords of the three degrees or answer any of the Test Questions of the three degrees.

Lastly it is always polite to advise a Lodge in advance if you are going to visit them, particularly from out of town, as this will assist their Junior Warden in making appropriate catering arrangements.
