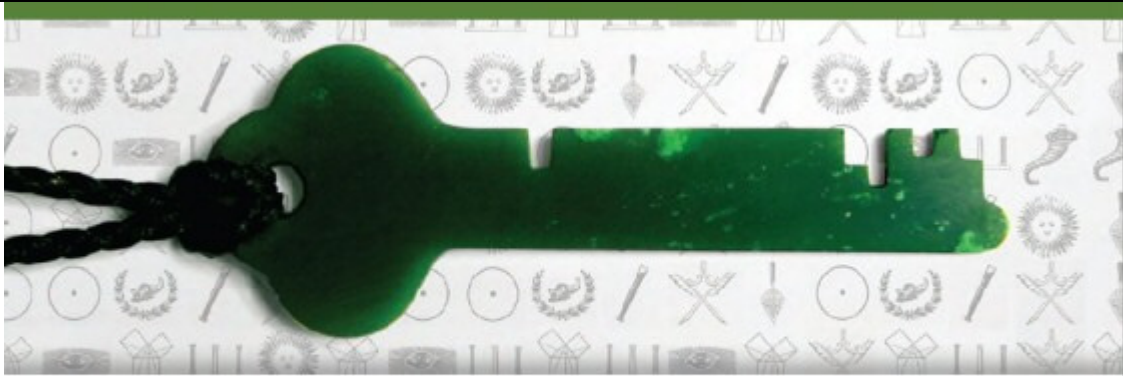

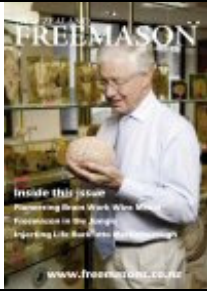
## Masonic Education at the Southern Division Conference
